If you saw the movie *Unplanned* you might still be wrestling with the realities of abortion as depicted through the true story of Planned Parenthood Director Abby Johnson. If you have not seen this movie, I strongly encourage you to do so or to read the book by the same name.

Abby was a strong supporter of abortion rights and believed wholeheartedly in the message that Planned Parenthood presents to the world. But one

day her world was turned upside down when she witnessed an ultrasound guided first trimester abortion.

What she SAW changed everything for her.

When a mother who is considering an abortion sees her baby through ultrasound, it can change everything for her too. Suddenly she is confronted with the personhood of her baby. The decision she will make is no longer about a choice but about *someone*.

Your Options Medical is a front-line ministry.

The services we provide directly impact whether a mother chooses life for her baby and herself. Beyond the medical services we encourage a mother to believe that the obstacles in front of her that are propelling her to have an abortion can be overcome; that her *tomorrow* does not have to look like her *today*.

Unplanned removes the mask from the abortion industry and shows us that abortion is painful, it is messy, it is violent, it is sad. Extreme late term abortion bills like the one recently enacted in New York and being debated in Massachusetts are presenting all of us with an opportunity to choose sides and to shape the future of this country.

YOUR IMPACT

With your partnership in 2018:

- 428 unique patients were served through 1,430 patient visits.
- 403 pregnancy tests were provided – 286 of which were positive tests
- 341 ultrasounds – including repeat scans for many women
- 77% of women served were at risk for having an abortion.
- 154 babies were born and 53 babies are due within months.
- 25 mothers attended parenting classes.

THE ANSWER TO LATE TERM ABORTION IS ADOPTION



In late July, “Nancy” reached out through text message asking for abortion services. She had recently gone to a clinic for an abortion but was told that she was past the 24 week cut off for Massachusetts so “they couldn’t help her.” Not knowing where to turn, Nancy called and spoke with one of our advocates who listened to her concerns. During their conversation, Nancy was asked if she had considered adoption. Not knowing anything about adoption,

Nancy received information about the various types of adoption and then requested a referral to an adoption agency. Nancy continued to reach out through text messages and kept the advocate updated on her situation. Nancy gave birth to a baby boy but decided to parent her son rather than release for adoption after realizing that it was fear that was robbing her of the belief that she could be a good mother.

If bills like the one proposed in Massachusetts* are passed, Nancy could have aborted her 30 week old son. The option of ADOPTION was never presented to her at the abortion clinic nor was she given resources that would help her parent. She was given only one option and when the clinic could not provide her with that option, she was turned away. She recently sent the following text:

“I am floored you have kept in touch. I hope to one day show you how grateful I am that you answered my text.”

CHANGING A LEGACY

When “Tara” realized that she was pregnant, she had every intention of having an abortion. Already the mother of a four year daughter, she and her husband were having marriage issues. She was justifying her abortion decision by the belief that her husband “would never change” and that having another child would just make their issues worse.

Before the ultrasound, Tara expected to be around 7 weeks pregnant but her ultrasound revealed a nearly 10 week old baby who was quite active during the ultrasound.

After the ultrasound, Tara stated “I don’t want to hear anything about abortion, I am going to keep my baby.” Tara saw her baby as someone who would be part of their family not something that was disposable. Her family was worth fighting for.

While the nurse was speaking with Tara, her advocate was entertaining her young daughter with a new puzzle to work on. As Tara heard her young daughter laughing, she began to cry: “I am so happy that I came here and that you gave me a safe place to work through this and for taking such good care of me and my daughter.”
